- Separate application provided by the Booster Club-in the High School Office
- Attended Randolph for 2 years
- Earned 2 Varsity Letters for RHS by scholarship deadline
- Preference may be for student in athletics all four years

CAMBRIA AMERICAN LEGION POST 401

- Open to any major
- GPA between 2.5 or above
- Separate Form**
Paragraph about future plans and a paragraph about why it is important to honor veterans.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE-RANDOLPH

- Business Field
- Upper 50% of the Class
- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that my apply

CLASS OF 1952

- Entering Field of Education
- In none of the above, the committee will choose a worthy recipient.

DAVID M. NIEMAN MEMORIAL

- Open to any Major
- Academics are not the determining factor. Recipient based on **DESIRE** and **ABILITY** to go to a post-secondary institution.
- Hand written essay required.**

DISTINGUISHED MENTORSHIP AWARD

- Must have attended RHS or CFHS at least three years.
- Minimum of three years of agriculture

EMS-RANDOLPH

- Entering Medical Field- *Doctors, Nurses, Other Medical Profession*
- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that may apply.

EVANS EDGEWOOD SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be attending Edgewood College

FIRE DEPARTMENT-RANDOLPH

- Firefighting or Medical Profession
- GPA of 2.00 or Higher
- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that may apply

FLOYD L. & VIOLA A. MCMORRAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Top 50% of the Class
- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that my apply

IRAL & BARBARA SCHREIBER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Graduate of the current RHS Class
- Must be entering the field of engineering or education
- GPA and class rank must be included along with a transcript showing classes taken at RHS
- Must have recommendations from two instructors and 2 outside the academic setting
- Must exemplify qualities of good citizenship, active in home, school, & community activities
- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that may apply

JAMES EVANS

- Must be entering the Medical Field
- Academics are not the determining factor. Recipient based on **DESIRE** and **ABILITY** to go to a post-secondary institution.

JEREMY D. GEERSTMA MEMORIAL

- 1st consideration given to student entering Business Field
- 2nd consideration given to student enter Medical, Engineering or Education Field
- GPA of 3.00 or higher

- GPA of 3.50 or higher
- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that may apply.

NATIONAL EXCHANGE BANK AND TRUST

- Open to any Major
- Upper 50% of the class
- Separate essay is required**

RANDOLPH LETTER CLUB

- Selection of the recipients(s) shall be made by the Letter Club Advisor
- Applicants should be in good academic standing.

RANDOLPH TEACHER'S ASSOC. (RTA)

- Priority give to students pursuing a career in elementary, secondary, or special education
- GPA of 3.00 or higher

RICHARD STIEMSMA MEMORIAL

- Separate Richard Stiemma Scholarship Application**
- Senior girl who has participated in the Girls Basketball program for all four years of high school. This includes players, assistants, dance squad, and/or managers.
- Separate essay required.**

RICHARD ZONDAG

- GPA of 3.00 or higher

RYAN (OP) JONES

- Separate Ryan (OP) Jones Scholarship Application**
- 2 or 4 Year College or Vocational College
- Community Service Essay is needed**

STEVE & CHRISTA SLINGER

- Technical or 4 Year College

WAYNE VANDERPLOEG FAMILY

- GPA of 2.50 or higher
- Personal Letter of Application is needed
- Preference will be given to students majoring in the education or medical field

TERRY VREDEVELD MEMORIAL

- Highest GPA pursuing a degree in PE or Health Education
- If none of the above, highest GPA pursuing education

VFW POST 9510

- Include any financial needs, physical needs, and special circumstances that may apply.
- Statement of reasons for pursuing a post-secondary education/list of goals

WILLIAM F. ZACHO SCHOLARSHIP

- Separate William F. Zacho Scholarship Application**
- Applicant must be continuing their education at a technical college preferably in a building or business trade (*all applications to a technical school will be considered*)
- Student must be in good standing
- Separate essay required**

ZACHARY B. SCHULZ MEMORIAL

- Separate Zachary B. Schulz Scholarship Application**
- Applicant must be attending a Technical College
- Applicants majoring in Building or Business Trade preferred, but not required
- Statement of reasons for pursuing a post-secondary education/list of goals
