### **II. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION**

- This scholarship is open to any senior female planning on attending a postsecondary school.
- This senior female must have participated in the Girls Basketball program for all four years of high school. This would include players, assistants, dance squad and/or managers.
- **An essay on the following questions must be attached to the application.**

### **III. SELECTION OF RECIPIENT**

The Stiemsma family will review all applications for this scholarship and select the most fitting candidate based on the above criteria.

### **IV. PAYMENT**

Payment shall be made following proof of completion of first semester and registration for second semester. Evidence of registration and enrollment must be made to the Randolph High School Office. Should the recipient of the award choose not to enroll the first semester of the academic year immediately following High School graduation, the scholarship shall be forfeited and awarded to the alternate.
